



Kindergarten/ New Registration

Please share this information with parents of incoming students in your neighborhood.

Registration for all grades begins at Cumberland on April 2, 2007 and continues through June 20. Cumberland registers between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. only. When Cumberland is closed, registration will take place at the District Office in August (dates to be announced).

The following are required to complete the registration process: **ALL DOCUMENTS MUST BE ORIGINAL.**

Step 1: Bring a current California Driver's License showing your name and current address (which must be within Cumberland's boundary area) to obtain a registration packet.

Step 2: Complete the packet. A check-off sheet will tell the exact information needed to complete registration. After completing all forms, return to the Cumberland Office with the packet and the following:

1. **Parent's Picture ID:** Current California Driver's License (name, address and picture MUST be current), or a California ID Card, or a Valid Passport or Consulate issued picture ID (passport and Consulate issued ID require 4th proof of address)
2. **Monthly Mortgage Bill or Rental/Lease Agreement**
(NOTE: lease agreement must be current and original.)
3. **ONE of the following:**
 - ❖ Current PG&E bill
 - ❖ Recent Payroll Warrant
 - ❖ 1040 income tax form
 - ❖ Bank Statement with voided check
 - ❖ Car registration
4. Your child's birth certificate or passport. (Your child must be 5 years old by Dec. 2, 2007.)
5. Proof of current immunizations
 - ❖ 4 polio (3 **IF** the last was given after the age of 4)
 - ❖ 5 DPT (4 **IF** the last was given after the age of 4)
 - ❖ 2 MMR (after the age of 1)
 - ❖ 3 Hepatitis B (prior to kindergarten entry)
 - ❖ 1 Chickenpox (prior to kindergarten entry, or for any child coming from another state or country)
6. Mantoux (PPD) skin test (date given, date read, results in mm., reader's signature)
 - ❖ Kindergarten: given within the previous eighteen months
 - ❖ Grades 1 – 5: given to new registrants coming from outside Santa Clara County within 6 months prior to first school entrance or transfer.
7. A child registered for first grade must have a physical form completed by his or her pediatrician within 18 months prior to enrollment.

NEW THIS YEAR: students entering kindergarten or first grade (if first time in public school) must have a DENTAL HEALTH EXAM dated August, 2006 or later.

Step 3: When the above requirements have been fulfilled, the registration is considered complete and will be accepted. Students who have not completed their immunizations must have a note on their doctor's letterhead stating the date of the appointment and the immunizations they will be receiving. While these students will have a seat, their registration is "in process" and not final until the immunizations are complete.

At the time of registration, parents may sign up for adult-only grade level tours conducted by the principal. Kindergarten Orientation is scheduled for May 8th at 1:15. This meeting is for adults only.
