KEY RESPONSIBLE 02

- ➤ Plan lessons & communicate with teacher for needed materials
 - Resources: Gardening binders and books in library



KEY RESPONSIBLE 03

- Manage small groups
 - Use a signal to get attention
 - Set expectations for your time together
 - Give each group member a role
 - Encourage positive behaviors by incorporating choices
 - Visual cues can minimize interruptions
 - Allow for a quick reflection of how things went at the end of your time together.
 - Consult with teacher if challenges are being experienced

- Garden lead available planting spaces
- Garden lead can support you in knowing the budget for materials.
- Connect you with other garden parents
