 - Consult with teacher regarding any medical issues for students.
 - Emphasize proper use of equipment
 - Establish safety expectations at the start of class
- Communicate with teacher on where to find PE equipment
 - Classroom Equipment available
 - PE Shed Equipment available

Tips to Manage Small Groups

- Use a signal to get attention
- Set expectations for your time together
- Give each group member a role
- Encourage positive behaviors by incorporating choices
- Visual cues can minimize interruptions
- Allow for a quick reflection of how things went at the end of your time together.
- Consult with teacher if challenges are being experienced
