




Attendance is very important! Please make it a point to have your child at school on time and ready to learn.






Nightly reading is essential to future success.

Kindergarten is an exciting time for everyone and and the teachers are thrilled to have a part in this experience with you and your child.






Literacy centers allow students the opportunity to practice the skills learned in class.

Your child will learn science through exploration and observation. Some topics include pushes and pulls, plants and animals, and sunlight.














Please let the teachers know if you have ANY questions and/or concerns regarding your child throughout the year.

We have outside recess daily from 10-10:20am. This is also the time for your child to eat a healthy snack.












In social studies, students will learn about good citizenship, community helpers, American Symbols, and important people.


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Each classroom has iPads and computers for student use. We have reading and math programs that support and challenge all students.
