4 Easy Steps to Become a Fairwood

VOLUNTEER

1. Gather your documents:

- TB Risk Assessment or Test Result (Within 4 years)
- Proof of COVID vaccination.
- Proof of Liability Insurance (\$100,000 minimum)
- Driver's License

2. Fill out the Volunteer Form online.

- You will need to upload your TB Risk Assessment or Test **and** proof of COVID vaccination.
- New: You can upload your Driver's Documents.

You will receive an email once your form is approved.

3. Complete Fingerprinting

- Fingerprinting must be completed at a District Approved site with the District form.
- Fairwood Alliance has offered to pay for all fingerprinting.
- Good for your entire district career!

4. Submit Driving Information

- New this year: You can submit your driving information online with your Volunteer Form!
- If you do not wish to submit your driving information electronically, you can provide a copy of your Insurance Declarations page and Driver's Licence to the classroom teacher.


