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## **Part 3: Chaperone Commitment**

Finally, each family is asked to support field trips by driving on at least two field trips per year per student. Once field trips are approved for this year, your child's teacher will speak to you about the planned field trips for the year and the chaperone needs for each trip. To ensure you are ready to support the classroom field trips, please submit your chaperone paperwork as soon as your class's Field Trip Coordinator requests it. The following documents/items must be submitted:

- ★ A Copy of Your Valid CA Driver's License.
- ★ Current Proof of Insurance with a \$100,000/\$300,000 policy
- ★ Fingerprinting through a District approved vendor

We will do our best to match your preferences to our school needs!

Finally, don't forget that all volunteers must complete volunteer registration through the District's new volunteer registration platform – Better Impact. The shift to Better Impact is supposed to allow us to manage your volunteer information year over year, meaning you will not need to resubmit your TB tests each year! This system will also allow us to send out reminders when TB tests or Driver Insurance documents will expire.

The platform is still being configured for our school, but it should be up and running soon! Once it is ready, you will be able to register, upload your TB test results and driver information, and submit. Once your packet is approved, you will be ready to volunteer! (Fingerprint reports are provided to the District on a weekly basis from the Department of Justice. Once approved, your approval date will be uploaded into Better Impact by a confidential District administrative assistant. It can take between 2-4 weeks for your fingerprints to be processed, approved, and updated in our system. Please complete your fingerprinting as early as possible. FREE fingerprinting and TB tests will be provided at Back-to-School Night.)
